

ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM CORE TEAM CHARTER

MISSION

The mission of the Environmental Management System (EMS) Core Team is to guide the implementation of an EMS at MCAS Camp Pendleton, to maintain conformance with HQMC EMS standards, and to facilitate participation in the EMS by appropriate activities aboard MCAS Camp Pendleton.

REQUIREMENTS

The EMS Team will:

1. Develop a strategy for EMS implementation.
2. Ensure that practice owners are consulted appropriately during the development process and that they concur in the resulting environmental standard operating procedures (ESOPs).
3. Assess the risk to mission from potential environmental impacts of MCAS practices.
4. Establish objectives and targets consistent with the Commander's Environmental Policy Statement, the risk assessment, and MCAS resources.
5. Establish a plan of action and milestones (POA&M) for achieving objectives and targets.
6. Coordinate execution of the POA&M.
7. Establish metrics to track the environmental performance of MCAS.
8. Develop an MCAS EMS manual and environmental management procedures.
9. Conduct EMS reviews and recommend to the CO, MCAS actions to improve the EMS and MCAS environmental performance.
10. Perform an annual assessment of objectives and targets, and conduct risk assessments as appropriate.
11. Perform an annual assessment of the POA&M.
12. Update the POA&M, environmental management plans, and EMS manual as appropriate.

MEMBERSHIP

The Core Team will consist of representatives from the Environmental Department, the Public Works Division, the Operations Section and Marine Aircraft Group 39. The EMS Coordinator will lead the EMS Team. The Environmental Department will support the EMS Team by providing an EMS Coordinator and other technical support as needed. The Core Team will meet as required.

DURATION

This EMS Team Charter will remain in effect until amended or revoked by the CO, MCAS. This Charter was adopted (date)
